Tube feeding, sometimes called enteral nutrition, provides essential nourishment for people who are unable to eat or drink by mouth, or who need extra support to meet their nutritional needs. Feeding tubes deliver nutrition directly into the stomach or small intestine. People of all ages may use feeding tubes, including babies, children, teenagers, and adults.

For Feeding Tube Awareness Week, landmarks, buildings and bridges across Australia and New Zealand will illuminate purple and blue as part of the #FTAWLightUp campaign. You can help raise awareness by visiting a participating location, taking a photo, and sharing it on social media.
